## 2018 UNITED STATES HOP CROP & HOP ACREAGE REPORT

On Dec. 19, 2018, the US Department of Agriculture reported that US hop production for 2018 increased 1% from 2017, yielding a record 107 million pounds up from 105 million pounds in 2017. Acreage in Washington, Oregon, and Idaho increased in total by 2% to 55,035 acres.

Washington State produced 73% of the hop crop, Idaho 15% and Oregon 12%. The leading hop varieties being grown in the US continue to be the "C" varieties, Cascade, Centennial, Citra and the CTZs.

In addition to the three main hop growing States of Washington, Oregon, and Idaho, nearly every other State in the USA is growing hops, although most of these states are growing a total of 10 acres or less. However, there were six States growing more than 100 acres, they are Michigan with 750 acres, New York 400 acres, Wisconsin 297 acres, Colorado 147 acres, California with 130 acres and Minnesota with 120 acres. The total number of non-pacific northwest acreage was 2433 acres in 2018, a decrease of nearly 3% from 2017.
